## **GPS** Test

Go to menu - GPS - Start Test and switch in on.

Then in menu - GPS - GPS MODE select GPS (only), activate the GPS.

Go OUTSIDE, where the radio can "see" the horizon, switch the radio off and on again.

Now, after the boot logo has disappeared, You should see, that the radio shows a

TEST GPS screen with changing numbers (coordinates from different satellites) on it. Only if these numbers never change, the radio really can't "see" any satellite - most of the cases have hardware issues, i.e. poor connections to the internal and quite small GPS-antenna.

If you see changing numbers there, getting a GPS FIX is only a matter of time. The first fix after a new initialization always takes long(er). Unlike a cell phone, which collects GPS ALMANACH info via units, lte or other, the radio has to collect this info via GPS satellites. That takes some time.
